Kindergarten ~ Mrs. Bullington

Hey Kindergarten Families!

We have been working hard to improve our handwriting, and we are making a lot of progress. We continue to read and to review our phonics sounds. It is amazing to see how far the children have progressed in their reading this year!

In Bible memory we keep reviewing Psalm 1:1-3, Psalm 23, Romans 3:19-26, and Romans 4:2-5, and we are now memorizing Romans 8:31-39. In Bible this week we are learning about the giving of the law and the 10 Commandments.

In math we are working on simple subtraction, and the kids are all doing awesome!

Report cards will be coming home tomorrow (Wednesday). If you would like to schedule a parent-teacher conference with me please let me know and we can get one scheduled. You can text me or call me at 815-878-0622.

Bible: This week we are learning about God's mercy as we look at how Jesus healed the blind man and others. Our verse is Micah 6:8: "He has showed you, O man what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God." We will recite this verse on Friday.

Phonics and Language: This week we are learning about antonyms, homonyms, and adjectives.

Spelling: We are studying list 25 words. Bonus words are: January, headache, onion, vegetable, and weather. Spelling test 25 will be given on Friday.

Math: We will be doing subtraction problems with zero's in the minuend, multiplying by 5, finding 1/3 of an object and a group.

Science: We will finish up our unit on plants this week and then begin learning about different animal homes and habitats.

Handwriting: We are learning the letters Mm, Nn, Pp, and Qq this week in cursive.

3rd grade ~ Mrs. Glass

Bible: Our memory verse is Isaiah 1:18. This week, we will be learning about a man named Saul. Sinful Saul became pure-hearted Paul.

A - Admit your sins **B** - Believe, repent, and receive eternal life **C** - Choose Jesus as Lord

English: We will be working with cause and effect. We will also work with topics and ideas from stories. Test on Friday.

Math - We will start using 9 as a divisor, reducing fractions by 6, and learn 4-digit dividend division.

Science: We are starting Chapter 5-Plant World!

History: We are finishing up our section on Thomas Jefferson. Test on Wednesday.
