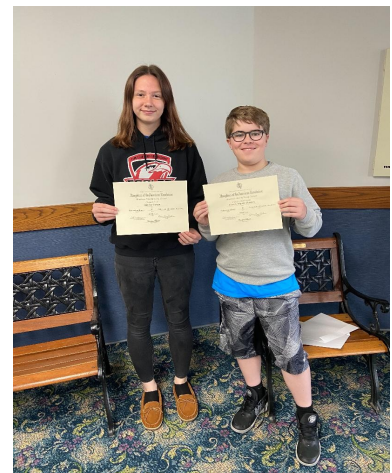
8th Grade Elks Essay Winners:
