TEACHER'S NOTES FOR YOU!

2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

Please continue to help your child learn their poem, fable, or Bible passage for the speech contest. We will have the contest in February, date yet to be determined.

Bible: We are continuing to learn about Nehemiah. This week we will look at how we can stand firm against the enemy.

Verse: "Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
Matthew 19:26

Phonics and Language: We will look at compound words, possessive nouns, and common and proper nouns. We will continue to learn capitalization rules.

Math: We are continuing to learn how to borrow in subtraction, determine half of a number using doubles math facts, 16 subtraction family, 4 digit addition with carrying, and 3 digit subtraction problems.

Spelling: We are working on list 17 spelling words, our test will be on Friday. Bonus words are sweat-shirt, penguin, muscles, blizzard, and synonym.

History: We will learn about the globe and its landforms. We will start learning the 50 states on a map of our country. We will be learning about Native Americans in our first chapter.



3rd grade ~ Mrs. Glass

Bible - Memory Verse: John 2:11. This week, we are going to learn about miracles that Jesus performed in the New Testament. We are going to learn about Jesus turning water into wine at the wedding in Cana. We will learn about George Mueller, a man of faith, and how God always provided.

English - We are learning our helping verbs - am, is, are, was, were, have, has, had. We will continue to learn verbs in present tense, past tense, and with a helping verb = verb phrase.

Math - We are learning fractions this week, such as $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{5}$, $\frac{1}{6}$, $\frac{1}{7}$, $\frac{1}{8}$. We are adding a step onto converting measurements. Test on Friday.

Spelling - List #18 Test Friday

History - We will be learning about Peter Cartwright. Test on Friday over the States.

Science - We will be learning about machines, wheels and axels, inclined planes, levers, pulleys, gears, and compound machines. Quiz next Wednesday, January 19th, over pages 14-30.

4th grade ~ Mrs. Odell

Our Scripture passage this week is Isaiah 53:5-7.

We are choosing speeches for the students to memorize for our in-house contest. They will compete in poetry, fables, or Scripture.

We are focusing on fractions in math. We are working on list 18 in spelling and we'll test on it tomorrow, Wednesday the 12th. We are learning of sound and hearing in Science. History is showing how our nation grew as it pushes farther west.
