TEACHER'S NOTES FOR YOU!

2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

Please continue to help your child learn their poem, fable, or Bible passage for the speech contest. We will have the contest in February, date yet to be determined.

Bible: We are learning about Esther this week. We will see how she followed wise advice.

Verse: "Listen to advice and accept instruction and in the end you will be wise." Proverbs 19:20

Phonics and Language: We will continue to learn about capitalization rules and abbreviations for days of the week and months of the year and titles. We will continue to identify common and proper nouns. We will learn how to use commas in a series.

Math: This week we will learn about Roman numerals, the 17 addition family and using digits to write dates.

Spelling: We are working on list 18 words. Our test will be on Friday. No bonus words this week

History: This week we will read and learn about the Separatists (Pilgrims) and their journey to the New World. We will learn where Florida, Texas, California, Maine, and Washington are located on a USA map.
