January Rehearsal Schedule



In Bible we are beginning a study of the tower of Babel as we learn how God orchestrated how people would inhabit the earth.

Our next spelling unit is list 14 and our test will be January 12, 2026.

Mrs. Bickett's Second Grade Note

Welcome back to a new year! I hope you had a wonderful Christmas vacation!

We will be getting either a fable, poem or Bible passage to memorize for the speech contest we will have in February. Look for those to come home by the end of the week. Students should begin working on memorizing their speech.

Bible: We are beginning a new unit in Bible this week. We will be looking at Solomon's reign and how the kingdom became divided. We will also learn about Elijah's challenge to the prophets of Baal and how God responded to the wickedness of King Ahaz. Our first memory verse in this unit is James 1:5 " If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." We will work on this verse this week and next.

Phonics and Language: We are focusing on identifying common and proper nouns, how to proof read sentences and capitalization rules. We will review how to make plural nouns by adding s, es, or changing y to I and adding es.

Spelling: We are studying list 16 words. Spelling test 16 will be given on Friday. This is a review list except for learning the definitions of the vocabulary words.

Math: We will learn the 16 subtraction family, how to use double math facts to find half of a number, subtract with borrowing in the tens place, and how to write monetary amounts 2 ways. ex. \$0.78 and 78¢

Science: We are learning about plants. We will learn about the different parts of a plant, and what plants need to grow.

Handwriting: We are starting to learn cursive. This week we will learn the letters Aa, Cc, & g.

Bible Verse – Exodus 3:14

Math – We will learn the next step in converting measurements. We will also work on roman numerals and fractions.

English – We will continue to work with verbs and learn helping verbs.

History – Starting next week and for the next two weeks, please help your child study the 50 states. This is a big part of their history grade. Test on Tuesday, January 27th.

Mrs. Lunger's Jr. High Note


Welcome back from our break!! I hope everyone had a great time away.
