Hey Kindergarten Families!

We are getting to a point in our reading where we would benefit greatly from some parent and grandparent volunteers to listen to students read—stay tuned for more details in the coming weeks and be considering whether you might be able to help!

We have started show and share! Each Friday a student will have the opportunity to bring something from home to show the class and to tell us all about it! Here is the schedule:

In phonics this week we are introducing diphthongs and glued sounds, and we are learning songs to help us remember them while we continue to review everything else we have learned so far.

Kindergarten Continued...

We love to practice reading the kids' readers at school and at home! All of the children are making good progress, and it's awesome to see how much they are learning!

We have been focusing on simple addition with manipulatives this week!

In Bible, we are talking about the gospel—the death of Jesus for our sins and His resurrection, and believing that gospel to be saved from the punishment for our sin. We have mastered Psalm 1:1-3, Psalm 23, and are working on mastering Romans 3:19-26, we have just started learning Romans 4:2-5. The kids are doing so well with Bible memory! Have a great week resting in the finished work of Jesus on the cross!

2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

Bible: We are continuing to learn about Ruth. We will see how Ruth was devoted to Naomi and how she was blessed because of her love for her mother-in-law. Our verse this week is Psalm 100:4; "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name." We will recite this verse on Friday.

Phonics and Language: We now know all the definitions of the four types of sentences. We are learning to identify nouns in sentences.

Spelling: We are studying list 13 words. Bonus words are: excellent, certain, hibernate, bouquet, and island. Spelling test 13 will be given on Friday.

Math: We will learn the 14 subtraction family, how to find an hour earlier or later when reading a clock. We will add 3 digit addition problems with carrying in the ten and hundred places.

History: We are continuing to learn about America's patriotic songs. We will also be looking at pioneers and how our country expanded.

Handwriting: We are continuing to practice forming our upper and lower case letters correctly as we write different Bible verses.

3rd grade ~ Mrs. Glass

Bible: Memory Verse - Colossians 3:17. We are going to learn about the ten lepers and how one (Samaritan) came back to Jesus to thank Him. We will learn about acrostic writing.
