We will learn about Thanksgiving this week and have lots of fun Thanksgiving activities. No spelling lists, tests or homework this week!


We earned a popcorn party last week. And we will have our party on Monday, November 23rd! The students are excited to try all the different varieties of popcorn. Yum!

History

6th: We are looking at the early colonial settlements this week.

7th: We have been working on comparing Christianity to Islam. Our focus has been on the distortion of God's Word during the 300's-1500's. We are also working on a faux stained glass piece.

8th: We are half way through our Constitution test. Students should study daily notes and be working on their Civics book. They have had this for three weeks and it is due January 5th.

Language Arts

6th: We finished the *Westing Game* novel: a *Who Done It* mystery. We are moving back into regular class-room work. Students have a poem to write over the break.
