We have enjoyed learning about different countries this last week. We had an around the world celebration to end that unit with the kids each picking a country and bringing in a food from that country. In phonics we are working on blends and consonant sounds. In math we are working on the 30 family numbers and 40 family numbers. Please continue to work with your child on writing their names.



Mrs. Bickett's Second Grade Note

We are collecting items for our Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes. We would like to do a box for a boy and a girl. We will need toiletry items like bar soap, toothbrushes, washcloths, hair brushes and combs, small toys and school supplies. Items are needed by next Wednesday, November 12th.

Bible: We are finishing up our 3rd Bible unit and will begin our 4th unit. This unit will teach us how Israel got a king. We will learn about Ruth, Samuel, Saul, Jonathan and David. Our first verse for this unit is Psalm 34:17-18 "When the righteous cry for help, the Lord hears and delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in Spirit."

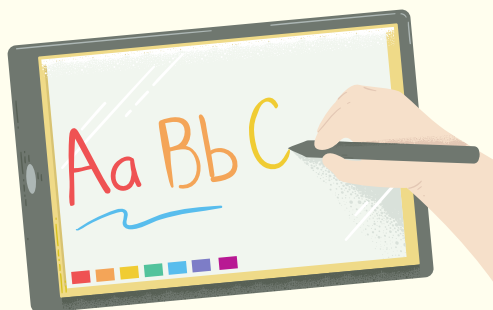
Phonics and Language: We are working on charts 11, 12, and 13 special sounds. We are continuing to learn about adding suffixes to root words. When a root word ends with a single consonant and the vowel is short, the consonant is usually doubled before adding a suffix beginning with a vowel. When a root word ends with a silent e, the e is usually dropped before adding a suffix that begins with a vowel. We will continue to identify declarative, interrogative, and exclamatory sentences. We have learned that an imperative sentence gives a command and ends with a period. We will also begin adding prefixes to root words.

Spelling: We are studying list 11 words. Spelling test 11 will be given on Friday.

Math: This week we are learning the 14 addition fact family and will continue to count different money combinations, telling time, reading thermometers, and measuring to the inch and half inch.

History: We are learning about Abraham Lincoln, the building of the railroad from the east to the west, and about cowboys.

Handwriting: We are continuing to work on our printing by writing various letters and words in a Bible verse that we can share with someone.



Mrs. Glass's Third Grade Note

Bible - Our memory verse is Matthew 6:31, 33. We will focus on Matthew, the tax collector, leaving everything behind to follow Jesus. We will learn about Jesus healing a blind man on the Sabbath.

English - We will work with nouns that cannot be seen and continue working with possessive nouns (ownership). Test on Friday.

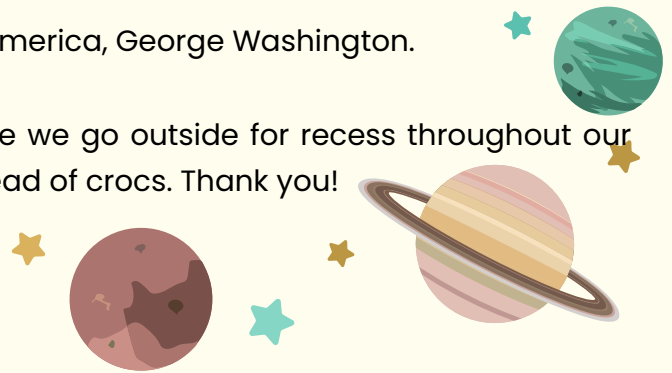
Math - We will start our multiple of 6, continue working with actual and estimation, and cross-multiplication.

Spelling - List #11 Test Friday.

Science - We will finish our chapter of space. We had a quiz today and will test on Wednesday, November 12.

History - We will learn about the first president of America, George Washington.
