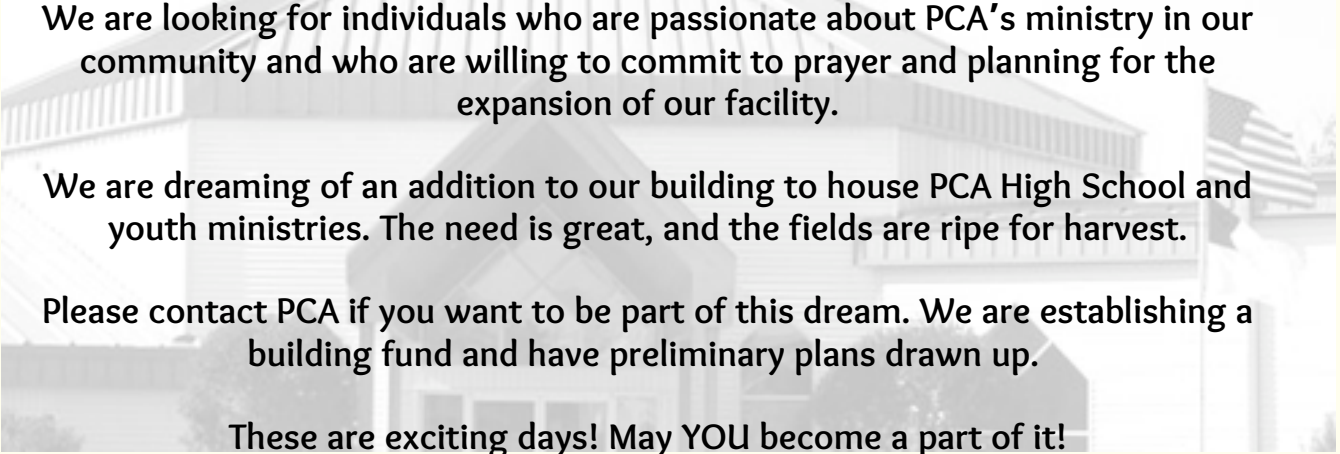

Mrs. Person's Kindergarten Note

In Bible we are reviewing the 3rd C of history which is catastrophe. In phonics we are working on our blends and we have learned and reading one vowel words. In math we are working on adding by one, two, and three. We are also reviewing telling time. We have enjoyed playing outside during this first snowfall. Next week we will be doing a gingerbread unit and doing some fun activities with that unit. Please continue to work on writing names and numbers in the correct formation.

Mrs. Bickett's Second Grade Note

Bible: We are still learning about David and how he came to be king in Israel. Our verse this week is 1 Corinthians 15:22 "As in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive." We will recite this verse on Friday.

Phonics and Language: This week we are continuing to identify nouns. We will learn the spelling rules for making nouns plural by adding s, es, or changing y to i and adding es. We will also work on learning irregular plurals that change their spelling. (child, children, person, people,...).

Spelling: We will have spelling test 14 on Friday.

Math: We will learn the 15 subtraction family, how to identify half dollars and how to count them. We will learn place value to the ten thousands place and how to add whole and mixed numbers together.

Science: We are learning about the world God has created and how he has made our bodies as we begin our science book. We will be focusing on our 5 senses and their corresponding body parts.

Mr. Clausen's Fifth Grade Note



Science – We will have a semester exam near the end of next week.

English – Students should have finished reading their biography by now. We are beginning the process of writing a book review. The rough draft will be due sometime next week, and the final draft before Christmas break.

For our Christmas party, 5th grade will participate with the Jr. High for snacks. Boys should bring drinks and girls bring a snack item. We will also be doing an ornament exchange. Each student should bring a wrapped (new or secondhand) ornament to exchange. We will be doing the exchange “white elephant” style.

Mrs. Lunger's Jr. High Note

6th grade Science – We are learning about geology... volcanoes, earthquakes, and the types of rocks in our world.

7th grade Science – We continue to study nutrition and health.

*** Each student should bring a snack to share and to evaluate its healthy qualities.

8th grade Science – We are finishing a three-chapter exam today and tomorrow. Thursday we will begin making polymer balls in class.

6th grade History – We are finishing a five-chapter review today or tomorrow before learning about the American West.
