Kindergarten ~ Mrs. Bullington

Our classroom Christmas party is next Friday! Thank you to Ashley Gray and Rachel Skaggs for planning and leading our party! We will start at 12:30 p.m.

2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

Our Christmas program is this Friday night. We are looking forward to sharing about the birth of Christ through our play and songs. 2nd graders will be dressed as angels in the program.



Our Christmas party will be on Friday, December 17th from 12:30 until 2:00. A big thank you to Jessica Odell and Tara Bohm for being the room mothers for our party. If you would like to contribute anything to the party please contact them.

Bible: This week we are learning about Nehemiah and what it means to be a good leader.

Verse: "For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations." Psalm 100:5 We will recite this verse on Friday.

Phonics and Language: We will finish chart 13 this week. We are learning how to make singular nouns plural by adding s, es, changing y to i, and changing the spelling of the word. We will also learn how to make a noun possessive.

2nd grade Continued...

Math: We will learn place value to the ten thousands place, normal body temperature and boiling point of water. We are continuing to count various amounts of money including half dollars. We'll be writing and differentiating between whole numbers, fractions and mixed numbers.

Spelling: We are working on list 15 spelling words, our test will be on Friday. Bonus words are Scripture, sermon, chocolate, ginger, and ornament.

Science: We will finish our science books this week. Our last chapter is about space and our solar system. Then we will begin our history book.

3rd grade ~ Mrs. Glass

Bible - Memory Verse: Ephesians 4:32. We will be learning about repentance and forgiveness.

English - We will continue addressing envelopes. We will even write a letter to one of our classmates and send our letters in the mail. We will start learning about verbs.

Math - We will learn or multiples of 7, measures of weight: pounds and tons, and how many feet and yards are in a mile.

History - We will continue to learn about Daniel Boone during the frontier years. Test on Wednesday, December 8th over pages 129-153.

Science - We will be starting Chapter 2 and learn about energy. We will read about wind, water, solar, and fuel energy. We will read about waiting and working energy. Next week, we will learn about electricity.
