# **TEACHER'S NOTES FOR YOU!**

# Kindergarten ~ Mrs. Bullington

Hey Kindergarten Families,

Reminder: If you would like to have a conference regarding your child's learning, please reach out to me and we will schedule a time!

We are having a great week learning and playing together. We have been doing a lot of one on one reading in our readers, and reviewing our phonics. In phonics we are learning a few more special sounds while we are reviewing glued sounds and diphthongs, with songs to help the children remember!

In Bible memory, we have been mastering Psalm 1:1-3, Psalm 23, Romans 3:19-26, Romans 4:2-5, and we have started learning Romans 8:31-39. In Bible, we are learning about the call of Abraham, our promise-keeping God, and the substitute He provided for Isaac.

In numbers, we have continued practicing addition, counting, number recognition over 10, and coin values. We are working on becoming proficient in counting by 5s, learning to count by 5s with the minute hand on the clock, and we are learning to read and write the number names one through ten.

# 2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

**Bible**: This week we will transition from learning about Old Testament Bible Truths to New Testament Bible Truths. We will learn how Mary and Joseph obeyed the Lord. Our verse is Matthew1:21 "She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." We will recite this verse on Friday.

**Phonics and Language**: We are reviewing capitalization rules and how to add suffixes. We will learn how to identify adjectives in that tell what kind and how many.

**Spelling**: We are studying list 25 words. Spelling test 25 will be given on Friday.

**Math**: This week we will continue to do horizontal addition and subtraction problems with carrying and borrowing. We will learn how to subtract with zeros in the one's and ten's place. We will multiply by 2 and determine the amount of coins and bills needed for a given amount.
