TEACHER'S NOTES FOR YOU!

Kindergarten ~ Mrs. Bullington

Hey Kindergarten Families,

We are having a great week so far of playing and learning together!

In Bible, we are continuing talking in greater detail about the life of Jesus when He walked on the earth. In Bible memory we have memorized Psalm 1:1-3, Psalm 23, and Romans 3:19-26, are mastering Romans 4:2-5, and will begin memorizing Romans 8:31-39.

In phonics, we are reviewing all of our special sounds and vowel teams especially focusing on diphthongs. We are learning a new phonics song to help us remember diphthongs. We are working in our phonics drawers to get individual practice encoding and decoding words. We would love to have any family members who would be interested, come in and listen to the children read. Please text or Facebook message me the day before you or a family member would like to help! The times that work best for us are 8:10-9:10 Monday-Thursday.

Readers that come home are not mandatory, but the more practice your child gets, the quicker they will take off with their reading! Some nights you may be too busy to do readers, and other nights your child may even be asking to read it twice through—whatever works for your family. When they have read their reader 6 times between home and school (there are spots to sign on the back!), they get a prize! These kids are doing amazing! If you have any questions about how to help your child with his/her reader, please ask!

In numbers, we are learning about simple subtraction while continuing to review counting by 5s and coin values.

We are learning about the lifecycle and parts of a butterfly.
