

Hey Kindergarten Families!

We had a wonderful time on grandparents day sharing our Bible memory and showing our work in the classroom! We have been continuing to review our letter sounds and have begun our very first readers! Some children are ready to bring their readers home to practice. They don't need to read the whole thing in one sitting, but once they have read the whole thing, you can sign the back. Once the reader is read 6 times, the child gets a prize! Please let your child sound the word themselves several times before telling them what it says if they are having trouble hearing the blend initially. You may have to remind them of the short e sound, as that is very challenging to remember. The readers should come back to school each day so they can practice at school too!

Kindergarten Continued...

We met our reading buddies today! These junior high girls are in my small group at youth group here at PBC, and they love to help listen to the kids practice their reading for about 10 minutes before our lunch Monday-Thursday.

We have begun learning some vowel teams and special sounds. It is much easier for children to hear the blend when long vowel sounds are used, so this helps develop their reading skills! We have learned oo, ee, ea, th, and will learn sh and ch this week too.

We have begun learning to count by 10s in numbers and continuing learning our teen numbers and counting by 1s.

In Bible, we will start talking about creation this week. Have a wonderful week thanking God for all His blessings to us in Christ!

Bible: We are continuing to learn about Moses and the Exodus from Egypt. We will see how God delivered the Hebrews when they were trapped by the Red Sea. We are reviewing Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23 and Romans 5:8 this week.

Phonics and Language: We are continuing to review charts 7, 8 and 9 special sounds. We will learn that every sentence has two parts, a subject part and a predicate part. We will continue to identify whether a sentence is declarative or interrogative.

Spelling: We are studying list 5 words. Bonus words are: language, Michigan, station, science, and calendar. Spelling test 5 will be given on Friday.

Math: We will review the review the 8 addition and subtraction families this week. We will use tally marks to take down information to use in a bar graph. We will learn to count nickels and \$5 bills this week. We will read thermometer to the nearest 2degrees.

History: We will learn about Squanto and the first Thanksgiving this week. We will also begin looking at colonial life.

Handwriting: We have now reviewed how to make all the upper and lower case letters correctly. We will now move on to lessons that allow us to write a verse to share with someone.
