TEACHER'S NOTES FOR YOU!

Kindergarten ~ Mrs. Bullington

We're having a great week in Kindergarten! We are continuing to work on memorizing Psalm 23. Students are bringing home phonics books they make in class. If you have time to read the phonics books with your child, please do so! Repetition is a great practice tool!

1st grade ~ Mrs. Baker

Fall is upon us and first grade is on the move! October is *Apple Month* as we learn and have special apple treats. We are learning new things in math and our reading is racing along! Keep up the good work, first graders! ~~~ II Cor. 9:8 - "And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work."

2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

Bible: This week we are learning about respecting authority as we look at Miriam and Aaron.

Verse: We are reviewing all the Roman Road verses we have learned so far this year.



Phonics and Language: Chart 9 and 10 special sounds, identifying declarative and interrogative sentences, and identifying the 2 parts of a sentence (subject and predicate), and learning about root words and suffixes.

Math: In math class we will read a pictograph, do the 9 addition and subtraction families, and do 3 addend addition problems.

Spelling: We are working on list 6 spelling words, our test will be on Friday. Bonus words are: habitat, addend, difference, ocean, and forest

Science: This week we will learn about different animals and animal habitats.

3rd grade ~ Mrs. Glass

Bible - Memory Verse: Matthew 5:16. This week, we will be learning about the "Beatitudes". We are going to see how we need to apply these beatitudes in our lives.

English - We will continue to identify our nouns in singular and plural form.

Math - We will be working with three digit cross multiplication. We will be starting division and learning perimeter. There will be a test over everything we have learned on Friday.

Spelling - List #6 Test on Friday

Science - Test on Wednesday over Chapter 7. We will start learning about the different types of animal habitats in Chapter 8.

History - We will finish learning about Squanto and begin William Penn. We will have a test next Wednesday, October 6th.



4th grade ~ Mrs. Odell

Our Bible passage this week is Psalm 139:1-12.

We are learning about the settling of the New World by the English in history and we should be ready for a test over chapters 3 and 4 on Thursday or Friday. We are learning about plants in science. We are studying how that word usage makes a difference in communication in English. Math practice of facts is always appropriate because we are dividing with remainders and will begin averaging, converting measurements, multiplying 3-digit factors and beginning fractions! We'll test on List 6 in spelling this week on Wednesday. Then we'll move on to list 7.

I am asking for them to decorate a little pumpkin as a character from a book they have read. They will then present an oral book report to tell of that character. So – please make sure they are highlighting a book character and not a movie character they have watched.
