Mrs. Person's Kindergarten Note

We are now halfway through our alphabet boot camp!

In math we have practicing counting cents using pennies.

In our Bible lessons we have learned about all 7 days of creation. We are excited to show off our Bible memory verse at Grandparents Day.

Last Friday we earned an extra recess for filling our bucket. We are now working for an ice cream party.

Mrs. Bickett's Second Grade Note

Bible: We are working on Psalm 119:160 this week. "The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous rules endures forever." We will continue to discuss the 7 C's of History as we learn about the nation of Israel and God's covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. We will learn why we can trust God's Word and how we can apply it to everyday situations.

Phonics and Language :We are continuing chart 6 and 7 special sounds. We are learning to identify if a group of words is a complete thought (sentence) or not a complete thought. We will also learn that a declarative sentence is a sentence that makes a statement and ends with a period. We will also learn that an interrogative sentence asks a question and ends with a question mark.

Spelling: We are studying list 3 words. Spelling test 3 will be given on Friday.

Math: We will be reviewing the 1 -4 subtraction fact families and identifying 3 dimensional shapes like spheres, cylinders, cones, cubes and pyramids. We will learn what a vertex is and how to divide shapes into halves. We will also tell time to the hour and half hour.

History: We'll be reading and learning about early America as we look at the different Native American tribes and then the Pilgrims.

Handwriting: We are continuing to review how to make our lower case letters.

Mrs. Glass's Third Grade Note

Bible - Our memory verse is Psalm 119:89-90. This week, we will learn about Christ being sinless, Messiah, man, and God. We will learn about the cross: how Jesus was the ultimate sacrifice and rose on the third day. We will learn about consummation: how Jesus will return, restore His kingdom, and sin will be gone forever!

Spelling - List #3 Test on Friday.

Math - We will learn our multiples of 3, geometric shapes, and money (quarters and half dollars).

English - We will be learning the subject part and the predicate part of a sentence. We will be learning our three joining words (and, but, or).

Science - We will be learning about birds and invertebrates.

History - We will continue learning about John Smith.

Mrs. Odell's Fourth Grade Note

We are so thankful for our families and the influence they have. We are especially looking forward to Grandparents Day on Friday as we celebrate our love for them and their love for us. Our memory portion this week speaks to this heritage. We are learning Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Philippians 4:8. We are also getting acquainted with Bible study tools.

Spelling test 3 is tomorrow. We have started chapter 2 in history as we learn about unrest in the colonies toward England. We will be working with verbs in English later this week. We're focusing on division in math, and we are skipping forward in our science book to discover amazing things about plants since our growing season is almost over!
